Teacher Strikes

Many of you will have seen that the NEU has called for further strike action for teachers on 5th July and 7th July. As explained earlier in the week, the 7th July is a day where the school is already closed for training so this will not impact parents. We have now moved the school's transition day to Tuesday 4th July and I will inform parents about any changes to operation on 5th July as soon as possible. If there is disruption to education, we will approach the allocation of school places on that day as in the previous strikes.

Transition Day 4th July

Transition day will be where the children meet their new teacher and class for September. This event will happen on Tuesday 4th July in the morning. Please bring your children to school as normal, including children in Nursery. We will take them to their new classes and send them home with a letter explaining the new class and teacher name. There is an opportunity to meet the new teachers after school on 4th July between 3:30 and 5pm. No appointments are necessary, parents just come to school that afternoon to have an informal chat, introduce themselves and ask any questions etc.

Sports Days

The dates for the Sports Days are shared below as these are different for the different year groups. As in previous years we welcome parents and family members to the school to share these events with the children. Can I ask, as in previous years, parents visiting this event to stay within the clearly marked parent areas at all times. At the end of the event, we will have time for a group photo and then staff will take the children back inside to get ready. This makes the event much easier to manage and ensure everyone's safety.

Telephone call recording system
