Sports Day

Bikes and Scooters on site

It is great to see that so many of King's Oak children travel to school on a bike or scooter. Please note that these bikes and scooters are left on site at your own risk and as a school we are not responsible for these. We strongly recommend that you provide your children with a bike lock to secure their bike or scooter to the racks provided. If an item goes missing then we will not be able to replace it. Although the school car park gates are closed for the majority of the school day, they remain open until about 0915 and then open before the end of the school day. If you do not feel comfortable leaving your child's bike or scooter on the school site please take it home with you.

As a reminder, can we please ask that bikes and scooters <u>are not</u> ridden on the school site as it is dangerous with so many people. This applies to both children and adults please.

Parking around the school

We have been made aware that some parents are parking on double yellow lines when dropping off and collecting children, particularly on the Oak side of the school. There are also occasions where parents are parking on pavements which blocks the path for pushchairs and wheelchairs etc. We know that the school gets very busy at these times but we would ask parents to avoid doing this and make alternative arrangements please. We are now working closely with the parking enforcement team at the Borough on this issue. Parking attendants from the council have been present this week and will continue to monitor the situation regularly moving forward.

Covid Signs

As a reminder to everyone, the main symptoms and signs of Covid 19 are:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
 - a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

As well as these, early warning signs include, but are not exclusive to:

- · Headache
- Upset stomach
- · Sickness
- Ear ache
- · Feeling achy
- · Extreme tiredness

If your child, or a member of the household are showing any of these symptoms, it is really important that the person showing symptoms isolates and accesses a PCR test. If this comes back positive, all who have been in contact with the positive person will need to access a PCR test and isolate until a negative result is received.
