Dear Parents and Carers,

Today is the last day of term and I wish you all a restful and enjoyable holiday. We look forward to seeing you all back at school on Tuesday 19th April for the start of the summer term.

Over the last 2 years, we have not been able to open the school to parents as much as we would have liked. As we move forward, we are going to change this and with this in mind I would like to make you aware of 2 exciting events early in the summer term:

- On **26th April** we will be inviting all prospective parents with a child starting reception in September to visit the school, meet some of the staff and have a tour of the facilities including a visit to the reception classes. If you have applied for a place in reception at the school or are thinking of joining us, this is the perfect opportunity to see the school in action. This event will take place between **9:00 and 10:30am on 26th April** and further details will follow when we return to school.
- I am delighted to announce that on Saturday 30th April, we will be holding our very first School's Farm Day. We would like to invite everyone to come and visit the school where we will be offering opportunities to read with the rabbits, spend time with the animals and sample the school dinner menu. There will also be the opportunity for new parents or parents thinking about joining the school in September to have a tour of the school and meet some of the staff. There will be a bouncy castle and ice cream van to make the event even more enjoyable! The event runs from 10am-1pm on 30th April and there is no charge for entrance. We look forward to seeing as many of you as possible this is a great opportunity for the school to offer more community activities as we move into the summer. After the Easter holiday, we will be returning to requiring all children to come to school in the agreed uniform, changing for PE in school rather than coming in their kits. We would also like the children to wear black school shoes or plain black plimsolls when in school. Today we are saying goodbye to Mrs Lowery who has been working in reception as the Ladybirds class teacher. Mrs Lowery has been teaching at the school for the last 3 years. We have also said goodbye to Mr Sheppard who has been teaching in Year 5. Both are leaving us to explore new opportunities and I wish them every success in the future and would like to thank them for their contributions to King's Oak Primary School.
